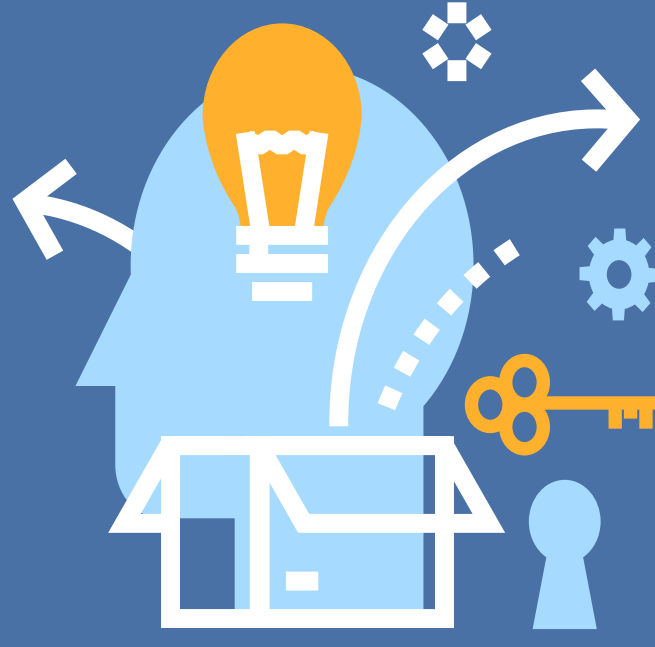


THE TOP 10 BARRIERS TO STUDENT SUCCESS

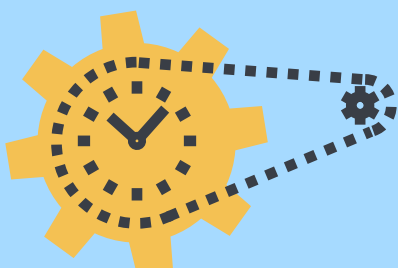
of educators agree that a lack of organization is the biggest barrier to student success

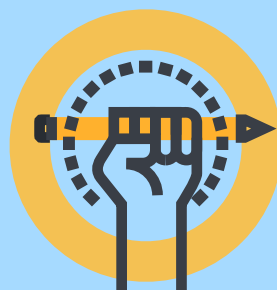
of professionals across the education industry attribute a lack of at-home support as a negative factor that impedes a student's ability to achieve academic success

Poverty and underdeveloped skills



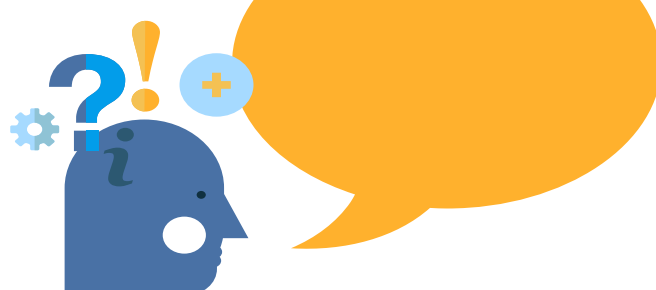
6 in every 100 educators

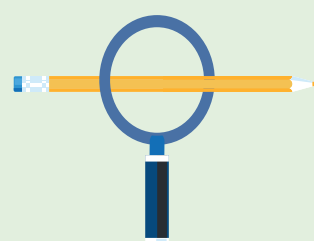
Rounding up the top 10 barriers: testing, media distractions, and class sizes each account for 4% of total survey responses

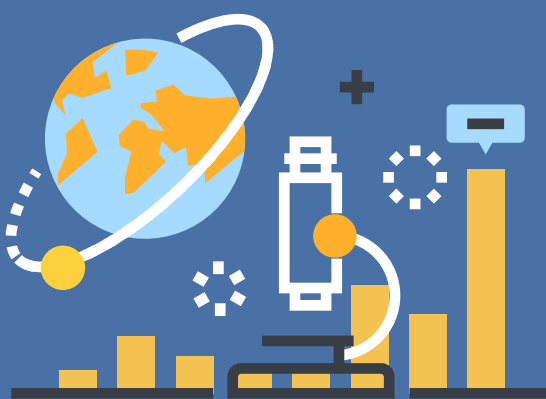
